Whether you are looking for a quiet day alone, a great place for outdoor recreational activities or planning a unique corporate or social event. A visit to the Environmental Education Center will provide detailed information about the entire park. Exhibits showcase the park's natural history and lead you on your park exploration. Trail heads at the Environmental Center are the perfect place to begin walking or bike riding on a variety of paved and unpaved trails. The River Center offers a beautiful wooded setting for large and small gatherings. Picnic shelters located throughout the park can accommodate groups from 25 to 250 and provide wonderful venues for outdoor events.

Located along the banks of the Saluda River, this 400 acre park offers the following amenities:

- 11,000 sf Environmental Education Center
- Six fully equipped, covered picnic areas of varying sizes
- 10,000 sf River Center, conference facility
- 10 miles of paved/unpaved trails
- Real Team Challenge Course
- Saluda Shoals Wetland Preserve
- Boat Ramp/Canoe/Kayak Launch
- Barking Lot Dog Park
- Saluda Splash & Playground

Seasonal Park Hours

Open Monday–Sunday 7:00 A.M. until sunset

November 1–February 28/29 7:00 A.M.–5:30 P.M.

March 1–October 31 7:00 A.M.–8:30 P.M.

Saluda Shoals Park will be closed on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

Saluda Shoals Wetland Preserve

Guests can view the diverse species of birds, animals and plants native to Saluda Shoals Park from the boardwalk.

Saluda Splash

Saluda Splash is a zero-depth, interactive water playground.

Open May through August from 9:00 A.M.– 8:00 P.M.

Annual Passes

Saluda Shoals Park Pass

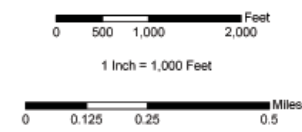
This 12-month pass entitles the member access to Saluda Shoals Park during regular park hours. \$45

Barking Lot Pass

A fenced, off-leash area for dogs. All dogs must be current on required shots and spayed/neutered. Other policies apply. Open during normal park hours. \$40 plus \$5/parking fee.

Fisherman's Pass

This 12-month pass provides the member 24-hour access to the park using a coded entry system. \$65



Rentals

Canoe & Kayak

Rentals are available daily from 9:00 A.M.–4:00 P.M. Includes all necessary equipment. A damage deposit is required. \$23/hour; \$38/3 hours; \$48/full day. \$5/parking fee.

Bike

Men's, women's and youth cruiser bikes are available for rent from 9:30 A.M.–4:30 P.M. daily. \$5/hour; \$15/4 hours; \$25/full day. Tandem bike: \$10 /1 hour; \$20/Half Day (4 hours); \$30/Full Day (8 hours). \$5/parking fee.

Tube (seasonal)

Rentals are available daily from 9:00 A.M.–4:00 P.M. Includes all necessary equipment. \$10/per tube/Two-hour rental. \$5/parking fee applies.

X-Plorer Packs

X-Plorer Packs, filled with fun seasonal nature activities, are available at the Environmental Education Center.

Team Building

Real Team Challenge Course and Off-site Team Initiatives

Low ropes course activities and off-site team building activities are available for both youth and adults. All challenges are lead by trained, professional staff.

Orienteering Course

Medium difficulty course for groups of up to 20 people.

Boy and Girl Scout Programs

Nature-themed workshops are offered for Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Brownies and Girl Scouts.

Saluda Shoals Park Trails Map

Trail Etiquette

1. Obey all signs
2. Stop at all road crossings
3. Be considerate of fellow trail users
4. Stay to the right except to pass
5. Announce yourself by saying "on your left" when passing from behind
6. Dogs must be on a leash
7. Dog owners must pick up after their pets
8. Respect the wildlife
9. Leave no trace, properly dispose of all trash

Tennis Center

Located on the east end of the park, the tennis center features six clay and four hard surface courts for tournament and recreational play. For rental fees and information, please call 803-772-1228.
