#### Provide and Install (1) 20' x 30" post frame structure to include the following:

- 1.1 Post Frame Structure to be installed on asphalt parking surfaces.
- 1.2 One (1) 10'x10' overhead door, no-insulated, manual lift (white)
- 1.3 One (1) 3'x 6'8' solid service door (white)
- 1.4 Completed 2" insulation in 20'x30' structure.

#### 3.0 Existing Conditions

3.1 Structure to be installed at Crooked Creek Park located at 1098 Old Lexington Hwy. Chapin SC. 29036 Site available to visit Contact Mike Hudson Project Manager email mhudson@icrc.net

#### 4.1 SUMMARY

A. Design fabrication, finishing, and delivery installation of post frame structure on site building.

#### B. Permitting

- Contactor will apply and submit all documents and license for permitting project with County Officials.
- 2. Design shall meet or exceed applicable building codes.

#### **4.2 SYSTEM DESCRIPTION**

 The design of a pre-engineered wood frame structure with single ply clear span roof trusses. The building is designed in accordance with the latest edition of the International Building Code Congress. Basic design loads will include live wind and dead loads. Framed openings will be designed to structurally replace the wall covering and framing they displace.



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#### 4.3 **DOORS**

A. Walk doors will be pre-hung steel-clad doors and a standard keyed lockset, with a polyurethane foam core. Doors are white in color.

B. Overhead doors, will be standard 24-gauge sectional steel, white pre-finished doors with inside lock or as specified.

#### 4.4 **FRAMING**

- A. Exterior steel siding and roofing is available in multiple colors with a forty- (40) year limited warranty by the manufacturer on the steel. Steel siding and roofing will be cold rolled steel (29 Gauge) with a baked-on finish. All steel siding, top and *bottom* is painted unless otherwise specified. All fasteners are color coded to match panels. Colors to be determined by owner.
- B. For the foundation, 4" x 6" or 6" x 6" #2 yellow pine, treated with CCA to a .6 lb. pcf. retention (tested by American Wood Preservers for in-ground contact) is used. Posts are set 4' in the ground on a 5" x 12" pre-cast concrete pad. 2" x 8" CCA treated boards are set on the ground at perimeter of building to secure metal to.
- C. Girts are to be 2" x 6" x 10' #2 Southern Yellow Pine or better, spaced 30" on center or as code requires. Girts are not treated.
- D. Purlins are to be 2" x 6" x 10' #2 Southern Yellow Pine or better. Purlins are set 30" on center on edge in between trusses using JP-Z6D MiTek Hangers. Purlins are not treated.
- E. Trusses, as per MiTek USA, Inc. engineer of manufactured truss components, are 4/12 pitch and set 10' or 12' on center with 30 lb. per square foot roof load. Clear span as required.
- F. Flashing, closures, and/or trim will be furnished at the rake (end), eaves (sides), corners, framed openings, and wherever necessary to provide weather-tightness and a finished appearance.
- G. Insulation, where specified, will consist of two (2) inch thick, 0.6 lb. Density fiberglass blanket insulation with a white 4 mil vinyl facing having an Underwriters Laboratory approved flame spread rating of 25.



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#### 5.0 Indemnification

<u>5.1</u> Hold Harmless and Indemnification - The contractor shall protect, save, and keep the ICRC forever harmless and indemnified from any damages (including fines or penalties) arising as a result of accidents, injuries, or other occurrences, caused by the negligence or willful conduct of the contractor, its employees, or subcontractors on the Property to conduct the demolition activities contemplated herein, regardless of who the injured party may be. Notwithstanding the foregoing, ICRC shall not be responsible for that proportionate share of the damage arising from the negligent or willful conduct of the contractor, its employees, or sub-contractors.

<u>5.2</u> Environmental Indemnification and Hold Harmless - The contractor shall indemnify and hold the ICRC harmless from any and all claims, demands, judgments, orders, or damages resulting from hazardous substances discharged onto the Property by the contractor, its employees, or sub-contractors in connection with the resurfacing or repair activities contemplated herein. The term "hazardous substances," as used herein, shall mean any substance heretofore or hereafter designated as hazardous under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 6901 et seq.; the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. Sec. 1257 et seq.; the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 2001 et seq.; the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act of 2080, 42 U.S.C. Sec. 9601 et seq.; or the Hazardous Waste Cleanup-Model Toxics Control Act, RCW 70.105D, all as amended and subject to all regulations promulgated there under.

#### 6.0 TERMINATION

For Cause: In the event of material breach by contractor, ICRC shall be given written notice specifying the 6.1 material breach. The County would regard any deviation from the requirements of the contract that was neither trivial nor innocent as being material. Such deviations are evaluated on an instance-by-instance basis but any deviation which impairs the utilization or value of the property to ICRC would be regarded by the Commission as a material breach. Upon receipt of such notice, if contractor has not begun correction of the material breach within two (2) days or has not substantially corrected the material breach within ten (10) days of receipt of written notice, ICRC shall have the right to terminate unilaterally and immediately services hereunder without further notice. County of Lexington reserves the right to purchase any and all services or other items thereafter in the open market, charging the contractor with any additional costs. Should such charge be assessed, no subsequent proposals or proposals of the defaulting contractor will be considered until the assessed charge has been satisfied. Additionally, ICRC shall have a similar right of rescission in any instance where contractor provides or seeks to provide any services for a price higher than that specified herein, without regard to cause, including governmental regulatory intervention and insistence. In the event of rescission, revocation or termination, all documents and other materials in the possession of ICRC or scheduled for delivery to the Commission relating to performance hereunder shall become the property of ICRC. ICRC's failure to exercise their rights to terminate under this provision shall not be construed as a waiver of their rights to terminate, rescind or revoke the services herein in the event of any subsequent breach.
